EMT Hybrid Course - Spring 2025

Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Prerequisite:

All students must obtain a Health Care Provider Level CPR card prior to the start of the class and be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 including a booster or bivalent vaccine. Proof of CPR card and a COVID-19 vaccination card are required at time of registration.

Students will need to obtain a Stethoscope, B/P cuff, watch with second hand or digital and penlight for use in course.

During the Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) course, you will learn about human anatomy and physiology, pathophysiology, patient assessment techniques, management of common medical complaints, management of the trauma patient, administration of limited medications, and concerns for special patient populations. Course material will be presented through lectures, simulation labs, and clinical rotations where students will interact with patients. Successful course completion requires obtaining the minimal level of competency as outlined in the National EMS Educational Standards. After successfully completing this course, students will be eligible to sit for the National Registry EMT Certification Exam to obtain certification.

There are weekly in person lab sessions on Mondays & Wednesday s from 6pm-9:30pm and several Saturday from 8am-4pm. There are also 2 hour online exams during the week as well as 10 chapters of intense studying required. Online assignments will be due weekly. In addition to the weekly lab sessions, students should anticipate spending a minimum of 20 hours a week completing the online learning component and reading assignments. This is a very intense class.

Attendance at all sessions and keeping up with the online content is mandatory.

Textbook is required and link will be provided by email by Course Coordinator once registered and must be purchased prior to the start of class.

Tuition: \$1,975

Orientation will take place on Monday, January 6th from 6:30p-8:30p. There are 20 chapters due before the first day of in-person class.
